Initial Driver CPC Module 2 Training Disc

Persons wishing to acquire a bus/coach licence after (September 10th 2008) and/or LGV, after (September 10th 2009, lorries) must pass the module 2, case study element. This is a new examination that has been devised by the DSA. You will be asked a variety of questions with multiple choice answers. The exam will use diagrams, video clips, text and audio to help illustrate the questions. Each test will consist of 7 case studies. In turn you will be asked 6-8 questions per case study. EP Training can supply you with a CD ROM to assist you in preparation for the exam. Driver CPC periodic training

Driver CPC qualification for drivers of goods vehicles exceeding 3.5 tonnes comes into force in the UK in September 2009. Every professional lorry driver will have to undergo 35 hours periodic training every five years. The 35 hours periodic training must be completed by September, 10th 2014 (for those who already have the C1, C or C+E entitlement). One advantage of the Driver CPC training is that the 35 hours can be spread over a five year period. As long as you attend a minimum of 7 hours at any one time.

This is by far the best way to implement the Driver CPC training, as:

- The cost for the training can be spread over 5 years.
- The course can be divided up over a 5 year period.

EP Training is JAAPT approved, Cert. No. CA 0110 to deliver Driver CPC periodic training. Courses will run at our Great Bookham training centre, or if preferred, 'in company'. Please call Sean or Ed on **01372 450800** for further course details.



Initial Driver CPC



As from 10th September 2009 (goods vehicles exceeding 3.5 tonnes) persons wishing to acquire vocational entitlement must pass the initial Driver CPC examination.

Obtaining your vocational entitlement will involve passing the following modules.

- **Module 1:** Driving licence acquisition. Theory test and hazard perception. Must be passed first.
- **Module 2:** CPC Theory Test. Case study and questions (consists of 7 case studies each with between 7 and 9 questions). Must be passed before taking module 4
- **Module 3:** Driving licence acquisition. Practical driving test (no change).
- **Module 4:** Practical test. Show me-tell me questions, to include practical exercise (restraining devices). Must be passed within 24 hours of passing module 3.

Train the Trainer Driver CPC

If a company wishes to conduct their own Drivers CPC periodic training they will have to confirm that their instructor/s have the appropriate training experience. To enable companies to meet this requirement, we are offering 4 day 'Train the Trainer' courses.
